East-bound Trains will have absolute right to the track over West-bound Trains of the same or inferior class.--- See Rule 84.

Trains will not exceed ten (10) miles per hour over Republican River bridge No. 1620. Trains will not exceed six (6) miles per hour around Wakefield Bluff between markers. Telegraph Signal Lamps are not required to be kept burning after the passage of Regular Trains for the day.

Special Rules Governing Crossing of Burlington & Missouri River Railroad at Concordia.

Trains of Burlington and Missouri River R. R. going South have the right to the crossing ahead of trains of Junction City and Ft. Kearney District going in either direction. Trains of Junction City and Ft. Kearney District going in either direction have the right to the crossing ahead of trains of Burlington & Missouri River R. R. going North.

This does not relieve trains of Junction City and Ft. Kearney District from stopping for the Crossing as required by Rule 94.

No. 51 has right of track against No. 54, Lawrenceburg to Concordia. No. 53 has right of track against No. 52, Lawrenceburg to Concordia. No. 57 has right of track against No. 56, Lawrenceburg to Concordia. No. 55 has right of track against No. 58, Lawrenceburg to Concordia. Conductors and Engineers of all extra or special trains must call for orders before leaving Colby.
