**ADDITIONAL YARD LIMITS:** (Rule 93)

First class trains will operate within the limits of Miami-Hialeah Terminal at Yard speed. Protection against first class trains when occupying main track within this yard will not be required.

All trains and engines operating on track between Jay Jay and Cape Kennedy will operate at Yard Speed.

**11. AUTOMATIC ELECTRIC SWITCH LOCKS: (Rules 531 and 533).**

The padlock should not be removed from the hasp of an electric switch lock, until the switch is to be used and it should be replaced in the hasp as soon as movement is completed.

Each electric lock has a sealed emergency release under a hinged cover which can be opened when the padlock is removed from the hasp and after breaking the seal the small release lever can be turned, which will release the lock. This emergency release should be used only by permission of the Train Dispatcher, who will inform the Signal Maintainer to repair and reseal the lock.

When trailing through electrically locked spring switches on authority of form "S" train order, switches must be lined by hand before and after movement.

Automatic electric switch locks are added precaution and they do not relieve employees of responsibility for compliance with the rules.
