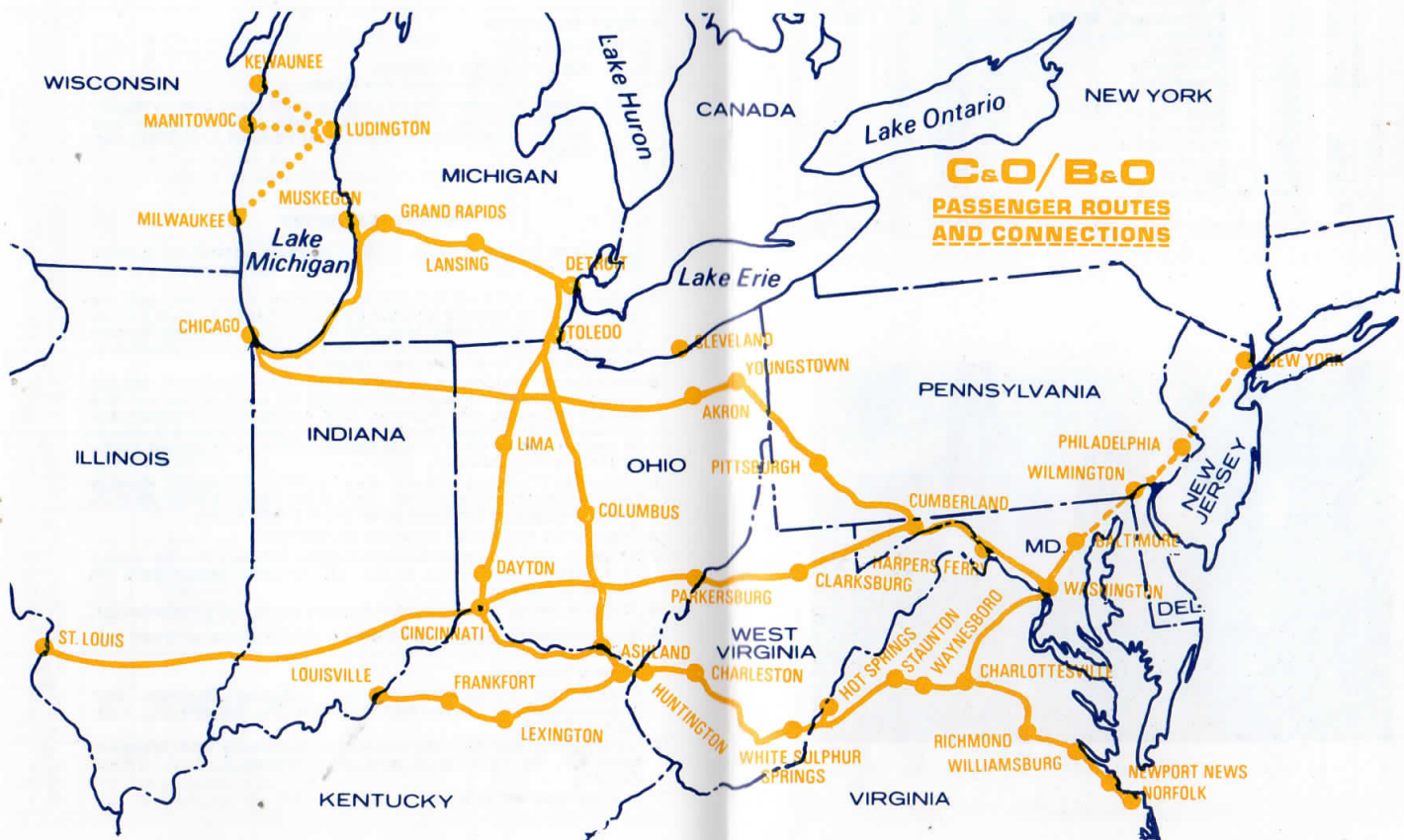
PULLMAN REFUNDS

So that you may obtain an immediate refund, Pullman space must be cancelled not later than the day before train departure. Just call any C&O/B&O ticket office.
