## INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE SALE OF CHESSIE STARLIGHT SLEEPER SERVICE

Total charge is the sum of the regular one-way C&O/B&O Local Blue Day Coach Fare plus the applicable room charge. For example, Washington to Chicago in a Roomette would cost \$34.50 in rail fare plus a \$35.00 room charge or a total of \$69.50. Children's Blue Day Fares, all First Class Fares, Chessie Pass and Employee Rate First Class Fares are valid in Chessie Starlight Sleepers. All other coach incentive fares, such as Family, Group, Military Furlough, Multi-Ride, Yellow Day, and Employee Coach Fares are not valid in Chessie Starlight Sleepers.

## MINIMUM NUMBER OF ADULT RAILROAD TICKETS REQUIRED FOR OCCUPANCY OF CHESSIE STARLIGHT SLEEPER SPACE:

Roomette—One ticket.  
Bedroom—One and one quarter tickets.  
Bedroom Suite—Two and one half tickets.

### TICKET REFUNDS

You may obtain refunds on partly or wholly unused tickets by consulting your local agent or by mailing the tickets, with an explanation of their nonuse, to C&O/B&O. Please send refund requests to Passenger Services Department-304, C&O/B&O, Baltimore, Md. 21201. When reduced fare, round trip tickets are returned partially used, the passenger receives the difference between the purchase price and the lowest fare for service used, less a service charge. The original reduction, therefore, does not apply.

### CHESSIE STARLIGHT SLEEPER REFUNDS

So that you may obtain an immediate refund, Sleeper space must be cancelled not later than the day before train departure. Just call any C&O/B&O ticket office. If the space is cancelled on the day of departure more than four hours before train time, only half of the original charge can be refunded. No refund can be made when Sleeper space is cancelled within four hours of train time.
