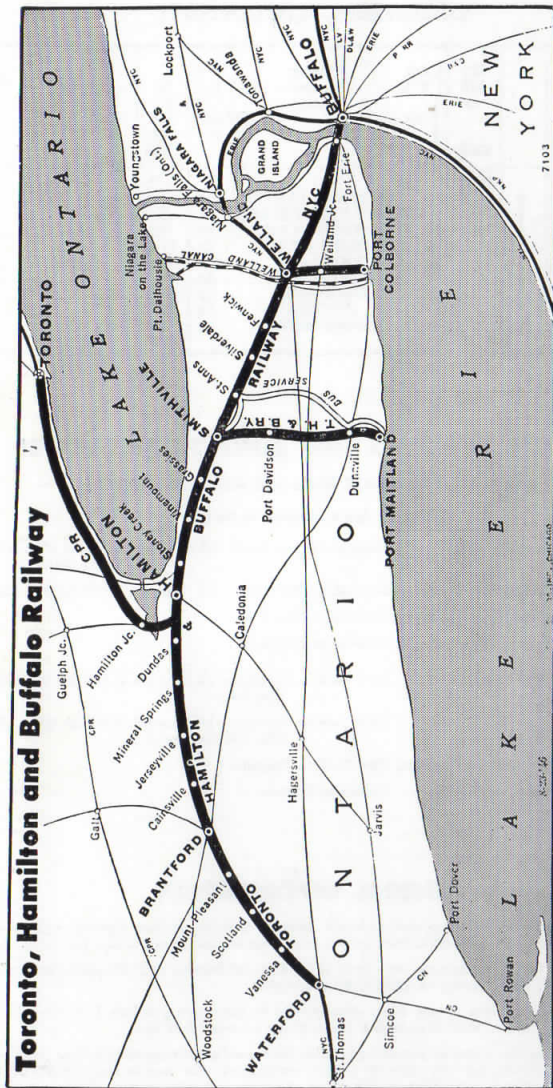

### GENERAL INFORMATION

This time table shows times trains should arrive at and depart from stations and connect with other trains, but their departure, arrival or connection at times stated is not guaranteed.

**Time**—Light face type denotes time from 12.01 A.M. (midnight) to 12.00 noon; heavy face type from 12.01 P.M. (noon) to 12.00 P.M. (midnight).

**Children** under five years of age, when accompanied by parent or guardian, free; five years of age and under twelve, half fare; twelve years of age or over, full fare.

**GENERAL**—In the event of any disagreement with conductor regarding tickets, privileges, etc. passenger should pay fare claimed, obtain receipt, and refer case to the Traffic Manager, Hamilton, Ont. Conductors have no discretionary powers in such matters, but are governed by rules which they are not authorized to change.
