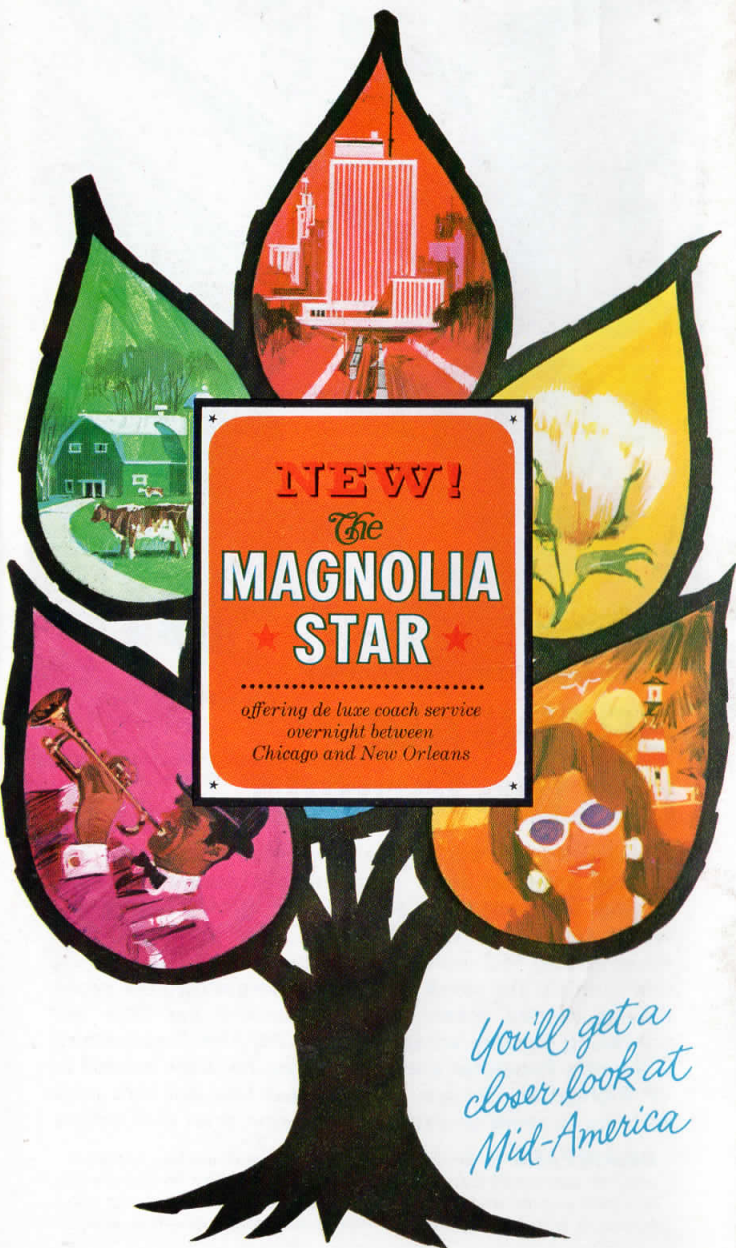

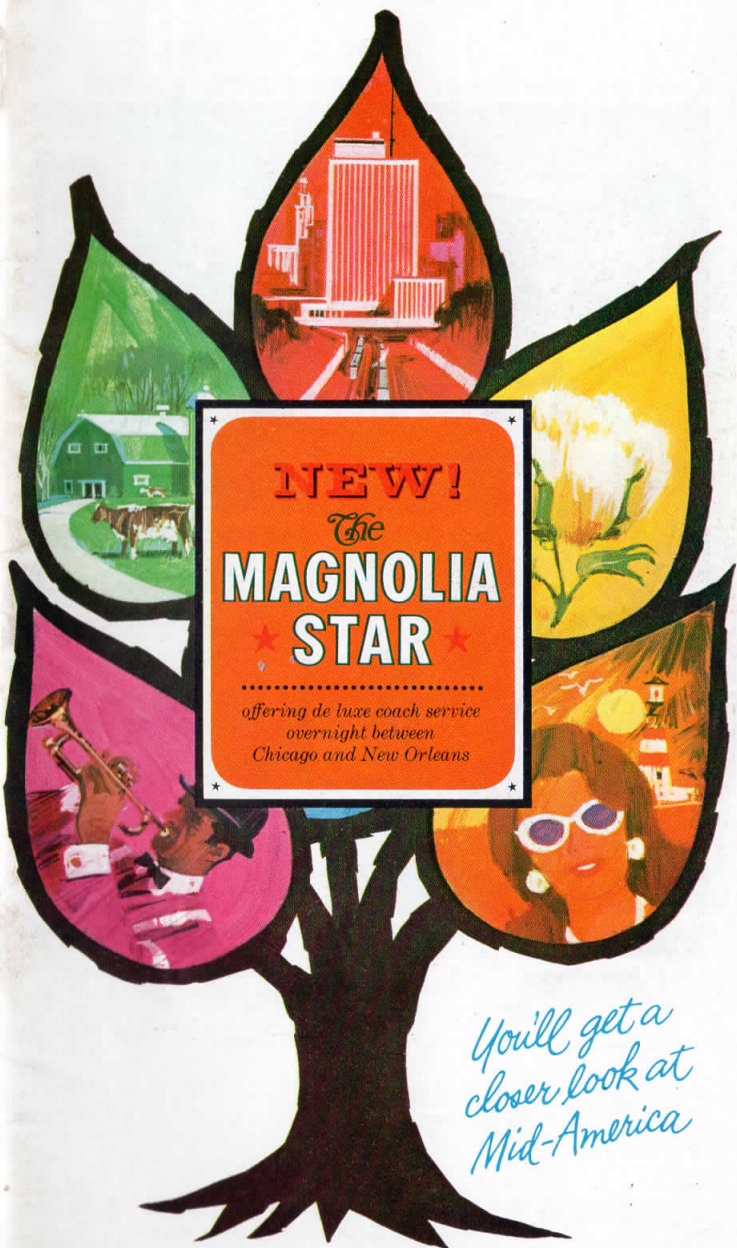

This is a new generation of travel timetables. Everything has been done to make it easy to read and simple to understand.

It's a small book rather than an awkward folder.

Its pages read from left to right and from top to bottom like any proper book, not like timetables that must be read from bottom to top and from right to left.

All stations are listed in an index beginning on this page.

The first eight pages offer you condensed information. Or you can refer to the following pages for complete information about all trains. Pages are divided by origin and destination. For example, all of the trains going south from Chicago to New Orleans (and points between) are on Page 10. Trains traveling north from New Orleans are on the opposite page. Trains to other destinations are arranged in similar fashion. We have eliminated a number of conditional train stops and reduced the number of reference notes.

There is an easy-to-read map. Toward the back of the book you will find detailed rail and sleeping car fares.

We hope our new timetable will help make your travels more pleasant and that you'll ride with us often.

Additional railroad or Pullman collection will not be made for a child or children under five years of age assigned the same seat or berth, including a section in which the lower berth only is prepared for night occupancy, nor when provided with additional berth or seat in the same room, as adult accompanying.

ADULT railroad ticket requirement applies, in addition to the Pullman charge, on room assignment, and a child or children five years of age or over, traveling unaccompanied in room accommodations, must hold rail and Pullman transportation equivalent to adult occupancy. (Exception—for a child five years of age and under twelve, the Illinois Central will honor a half-fare rail ticket for occupancy of a roomette on trains not affording berth service.)

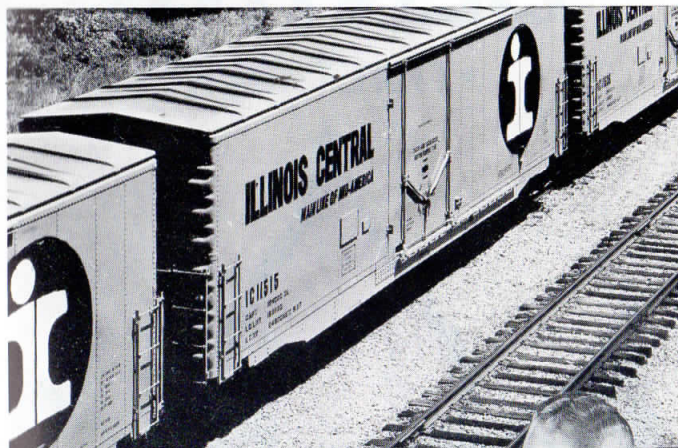
