GROUP FARES—Up to 30% discount for groups of adults traveling in coaches. Up to 10% discount on transportation and accommodation charges in Club Cars and (between October 1 and May 31) Sleeping Cars.

FAMILY FARES—Families traveling GT-CN receive 10% savings on the total cost of rail and accommodation charges between cities where the Red fare is \$6.00 or more. This is in addition to free rail transportation for children under 5 and half-rate transportation for children 5-11.

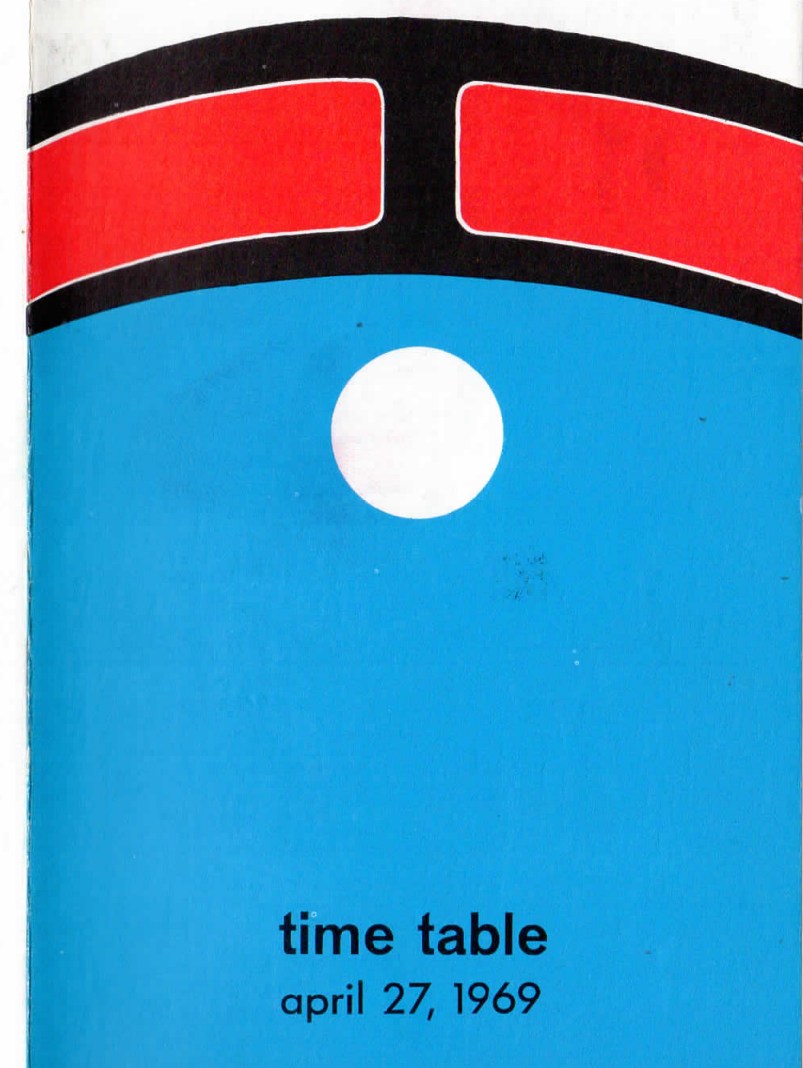
