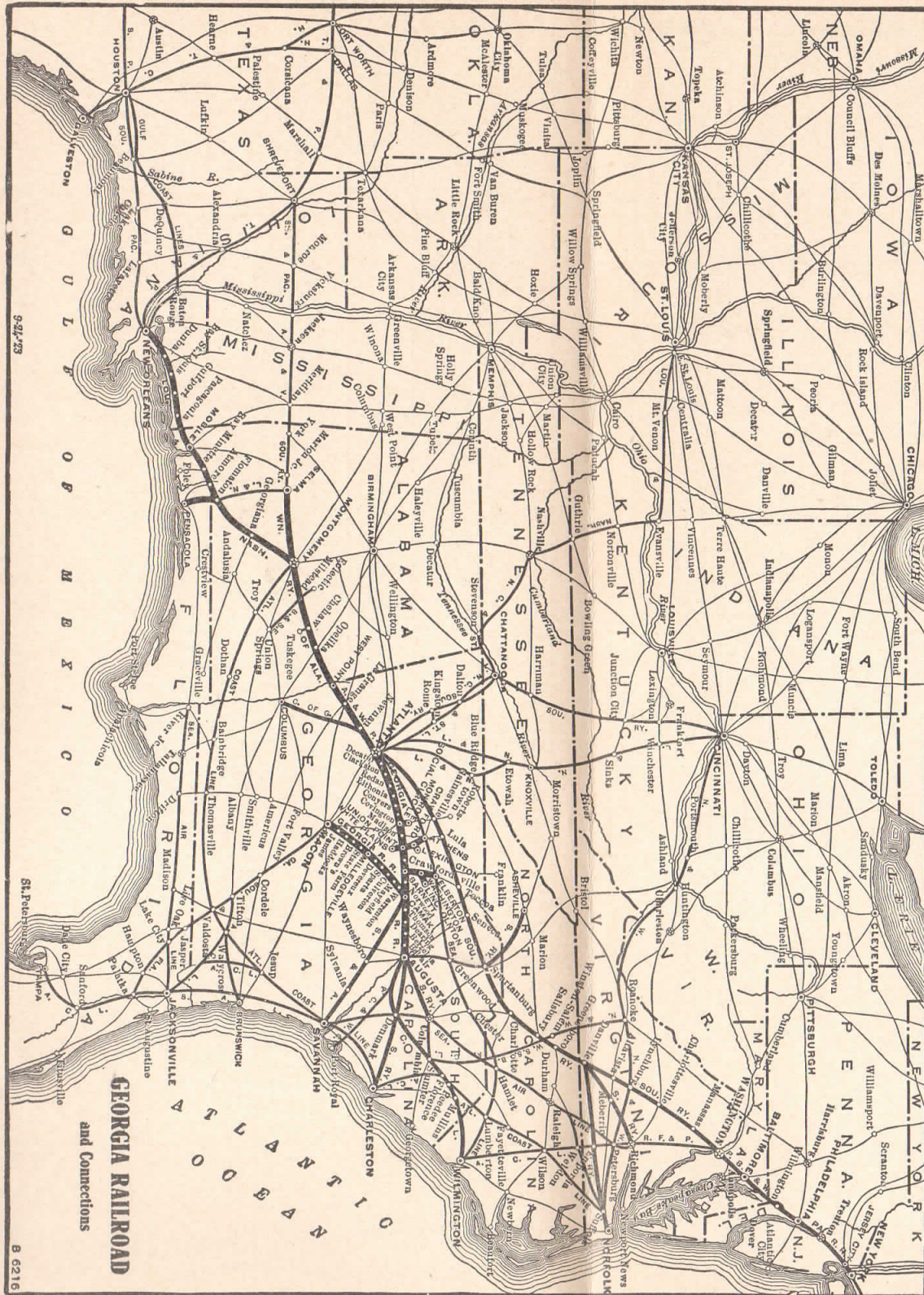

GENERAL INFORMATION

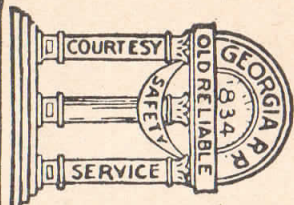
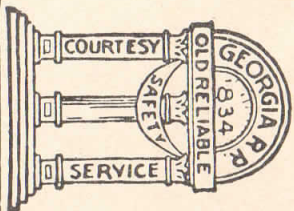
