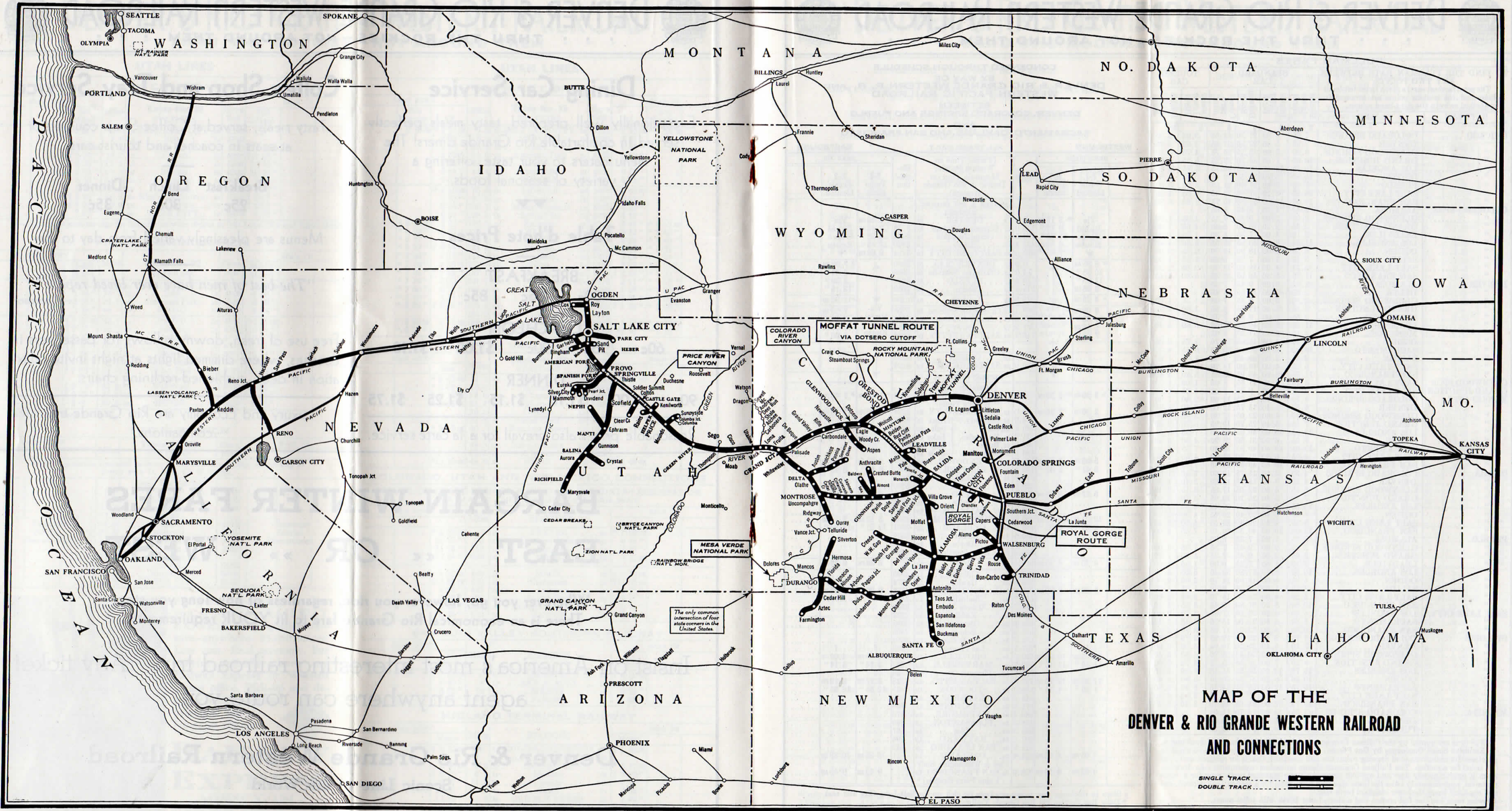

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GENERAL INFORMATION

SPECIAL NOTICE. The time shown in this folder is subject to change without notice; it is that at which trains may be expected to arrive at and depart from the several stations, but their arrival or departure at the time stated is not guaranteed, nor does this Company hold itself responsible for any delay or any consequences arising therefrom.

ADJUSTMENT OF FARES. Should any difference arise between yourself and the conductor, or train auditor, pay the fare requested, take receipt for the amount, and refer the matter to the General Passenger Office for adjustment.

PASSENGERS ARE NOT ALLOWED to stand in vestibules or on platforms of cars. It is safer to remain seated while the train is in motion.

STOPOVERS ON RAILROAD TICKETS. Practically all regular one way local and interline tickets carry a limit of thirty days in addition to date of sale and stopovers are permitted at pleasure of passenger within such limit. All year tourist and round trip summer tourist tickets to, from or via points on Denver & Rio Grande Western permit of stopovers at pleasure, unless otherwise provided in contract of ticket.

FREE SIDE TRIP PUEBLO TO COLORADO SPRINGS OR DENVER* AND RETURN. Side trip tickets will be furnished upon application, westbound to Mo. Pac. conductor or eastbound to D. & R. G. W. conductor into Pueblo, to holders of tickets reading over the Mo. Pac., sold at stations east of and including Geneseo, Kan., destined to Salt Lake City, Utah, or points beyond, or including Geneseo, Kan., destined to Salt Lake City, Utah, or points beyond, or the reverse. The side trip coupons may also be included in original ticket at the time of purchase or secured upon presentation of the through tickets within their limits to UNION DEPOT TICKET AGENT IN PUEBLO, COLO.

*Applies to Denver only on summer excursion and all-year excursion tickets.

FREE SIDE TRIP SALT LAKE CITY TO OGDEN AND RETURN. Available to holders of all classes of tickets sold at Denver, Colorado Springs or Pueblo, Colorado, and points east, north or south thereof to destination beyond Salt Lake City, Utah, via Western Pacific Railway and to Lyndyl, Utah, and destinations beyond via U. P. R. R. or the reverse. This side trip from Salt Lake City, Utah to Ogdem, Utah and return via D. & R. G. W. may be included in through ticket at time of sale, or furnished by D. & R. G. W. agent at Salt Lake City, without additional charge.

FREE SIDE TRIP DENVER TO COLORADO SPRINGS AND RETURN. Arrangements are in effect whereby passengers may obtain free side trips Denver to Colorado Springs and return on certain tickets without additional charge. Side trip tickets may be included in original ticket, or obtained upon presentation of through round-trip excursion ticket, within limit, at Denver Union Station, or any C. B. & Q., C. R. I. & P. or U. P. ticket office at Denver.

CHOICE OF ROUTES. Tickets reading via D. & R. G. W. between Denver, Colorado Springs or Pueblo and Salt Lake City or Ogdem will be honored either via Canon City and the Royal Gorge or via the Moffat Tunnel Route (Dotsero Cut-off), except as otherwise provided by tariff.

Tickets reading via the D. & R. G. W. R. R., sold at Salida, Colo., or points east or south thereof, and destined to Grand Junction, Colo., or points west thereof, or the reverse, will be honored either via Leadville and Glenwood Springs, or via Marshall Pass and the Black Canon of the Gunnison, except that tickets endorsed "via Gunnison" will be honored only via route specified.

INTERCHANGEABLE SCRIP BOOKS, bearing limit of one year from date of sale, are on sale at all of the principal ticket offices of the Denver & Rio Grande Western R. R., at fares of \$15.00, \$30.00 and \$90.00. Coupons contained in these scrip books will be honored at face value by all the larger railroads, for any number of persons, in payment of passage on trains in coaches, parlor or sleeping cars; in payment for tickets at tariff fares; charges for meals in dining cars; also in payment for baggage charges, etc.

INDIVIDUAL EXCESS WEIGHT BAGGAGE COUPON BOOKS, bearing limit of one year in addition to date of sale are on sale at all ticket offices of the Denver & Rio Grande Western. These books contain transportation to the value of \$15.00 and cost \$10.00. Coupons from these books will be honored at face value in payment of excess weight baggage charges.

CHILDREN. Children under five years old are carried free when accompanied by parents or guardian; those who have reached or passed their fifth birthday and are under twelve years of age require a half ticket; those who have reached or passed their twelfth birthday require an adult ticket.

EXCESS TRAIN FARES. Passengers without tickets boarding trains of the Denver & Rio Grande Western Railroad at stations furnishing proper facilities for the purchase thereof, will be required to pay the following amounts, in addition to the regular published tariff fares: Where the fare is 50 cents, or less, an excess of 10 cents; more than 50 cents, and not more than \$1.00, an excess of 15 cents; more than \$1.00, and not more than \$1.50, an excess of 20 cents; more than \$1.50, an excess of 25 cents.

PULLMAN RESERVATIONS. Pullman reservations to points on these lines, or beyond, can be made by addressing any Agent or Passenger Representative of the Denver & Rio Grande Western.

NUMBER OF RAIL TICKETS REQUIRED FOR OCCUPANCY OF DRAWING ROOM OR COMPARTMENT. One and one-fourth first-class adult rail tickets or equivalent thereto are required from individual passengers occupying drawing rooms and one and one-tenth tickets for compartments in standard sleeping cars, either locally or in through cars via these lines.

BEFORE BOARDING TRAINS ask the ticket agent, brakeman, or conductor whether the train stops at the station to which you may be ticketed. There are stations at which some trains do not stop.

STOPPING TRAINS ON SIGNAL. Where trains are scheduled to stop only on signal, passengers on trains must give advance notice to conductor, and persons intending to board trains must advise agent to that effect, in order that necessary arrangement may be perfected.

BAGGAGE REGULATIONS. One hundred and fifty pounds of baggage, consisting of personal wearing apparel, not exceeding one hundred dollars (\$100.00) in value will be checked free on each first-class adult's ticket, and seventy-five pounds, not exceeding fifty dollars (\$50.00) in value, will be checked free on each first-class child's ticket. Clergy-fare tickets presented in connection with Clergy Permits will be treated as full tickets.

Baggage will not be checked beyond Atlantic or Pacific Coast terminals. Baggage checked to a station having no agent must be called for at the baggage car by owner upon reaching such station and duplicate checks surrendered to train baggage man; otherwise baggage will be carried to first station beyond where there is an agent.

No piece of baggage weighing more than 300 pounds will be received for checking as baggage.

Unless a greater sum is declared by the passenger and charges paid for increased valuation at time of delivery to carrier, the value of baggage belonging to or checked for an adult passenger shall be deemed and agreed to be not in excess of \$100.00, and the value of the baggage belonging to or checked for a child traveling on a half-ticket shall be deemed and agreed to be not in excess of \$50.00.

STORAGE. Storage will be charged on each piece of baggage either in or outbound, checked or not checked, remaining at a station over twenty-four hours, except that baggage received any time Saturday will be held until same hour Monday. Baggage received any hour Sunday will be held until midnight Monday without charge, but if baggage is not claimed within such periods, then Sunday shall be included in computing the charge. This exception also applies to legal holidays.

DOGS. Dogs are not allowed in coaches. When accompanied by passenger presenting valid transportation, dogs not exceeding twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) in value and not intended for other persons nor for sale, if properly muzzled and provided with strong, securely fitting collar or harness, on chain or other strong leash, or in substantial crates with strong handles will be transported in baggage service under a revenue check and charge made at excess baggage rates for gross weight. The minimum charge for each dog on leash will be the same as for fifty (50) pounds of excess weight baggage and the minimum charge for one or more dogs in each crate will be the same as for twenty-five (25) pounds of excess weight baggage. Dogs not in crates will not be checked beyond junction points where wagon or ferry transfer is required. Dogs exceeding \$25.00 in value will not be transported in regular baggage service.

GUNS AND CLUB PARAPHERNALIA. Guns (unloaded), in wooden, leather or other substantial rigid cases only, club paraphernalia, such as baseball, cricket, football, fishing rods, golf, lodge, polo, lacrosse, soccer, in trunks or other suitable containers, securely locked or fastened, will be included in weight and value of passenger's baggage.

FOR CORPSE transported in baggage car a one-way adult first-class ticket, with minimum of \$1.20 will be required (regardless of age) in addition to the proper transportation for the escort, who must accompany the corpse on the same train (with transit permit issued by proper authority). A corpse thus ticketed and presented for shipment will be forwarded under baggage check, but will not be checked beyond a junction point where wagon transfer is required between depots and escort must make his own arrangements for the transfer and for checking of corpse beyond, except that via points authorized by tariff, corpse may be checked through.

HAND BAGGAGE. As a matter of precaution, it is suggested that all hand baggage should show the name and permanent address of owner so that it can be returned promptly in case of error.

Hand baggage is not permitted in the aisles of coaches, chair cars or sleepers and must be restricted in size so that it will go under the seats or in berths.

LOST ARTICLES. Agents will do all in their power to assist in the recovery of lost articles. Passengers should not only give full description of the property, but should state date of loss, number of train and whether left in coach or Pullman car. All lost articles found in coaches on Denver & Rio Grande Western are forwarded to C. W.
