

## GENERAL INFORMATION

### SCHEDULES—SERVICE

**Stops** — Trains do not stop where no time is shown.

**Schedules Subject to Change** — Schedules are subject to change without notice. M.P.R.R. — T.P.Ry. assume no responsibility for errors in time tables, inconvenience or damage resulting from delayed trains or failure to make connections.

**Mileage** — Mileage shown is for passengers information — not for computing fares.

### TICKETS—(LOST, REDEMPTION, ETC.)

**Children** — under five years of age travel free when accompanied by parent or guardian; five years of age and under twelve, one-half fare; twelve years of age and over, full fare.

**Adjustment of Fares** — In event of a difference of opinion with conductors or agents, please pay the fare quoted; request receipt and communicate with Passenger Traffic Manager, 1601 Missouri Pacific Building, St. Louis, Mo. 63103.

**Lost Tickets** — Should you lose your ticket, pay cash fare to conductor, or purchase another ticket; request receipt and report details of loss to Passenger Traffic Manager of the railroad from which you purchased your original ticket.

**Redemption of Tickets** — Tickets unused or partially used will be redeemed under tariff regulations. Mail such transportation to Passenger Traffic Manager of the railroad from which you purchased it.

### BAGGAGE—(MARKING, ALLOWANCE, LIABILITY, ETC.)

Baggage you will not need enroute may be checked for moderate service charge. Please tag each piece with your name and address. M.P.R.R. — T.P. Ry. cannot guarantee checked baggage will move on same train you use. Checking baggage a day or two prior to your trip provides greater assurance of its arrival at destination with or in advance of your arrival.

150 pounds of baggage, not exceeding \$100 in value, will be checked without charge for excess weight or value for each adult passenger; 75 pounds, not exceeding \$50 in value for each child on half-fare ticket. Checked baggage is subject to tariff regulations as to contents, weight and value.

Unless you declare value in excess of the above amounts when you check your baggage, and pay for increased valuation, i.e., purchase excess value stamps (or in lieu thereof, St. Paul Fire and Marine Insurance Co. policy) to cover excess value, baggage checked for each adult shall be deemed to be of \$100 or less value, and for each child on half-fare ticket shall be deemed to be of \$50 or less value.

No single piece of baggage exceeding 300 pounds in weight, or \$2,500 in value, will be checked; nor will all the baggage of any one passenger, declared to exceed \$2,500 in value, be accepted.

Money, jewelry, negotiable papers, etc. and such property as radios, household goods, liquids, explosives, fragile or perishable articles, are not checkable baggage; and M.P.R.R.—T.P.Ry. will not be responsible for baggage containing these or other items prohibited by tariff, nor for damage caused by same.

Baby carriages, and similar articles enumerated in tariff, when used in connection with your journey, will be checked and included in weight and value of your baggage.

Dogs, Cats and Birds. — In the United States, dogs, cats, birds and other household pets, when in baskets or other containers, may be taken into private room accommodations of sleeping cars. Or, they may be transported in baggage service, subject to tariff regulations.
