United States Custom Officers will examine all passengers and their
 hand baggage, and United States Immigration Officers will examine all
 passengers, on arrival of northbound trains at St. Albans, Vt. Pullman
 porters will awaken sleeping car passengers shortly before arrival at
 St. Albans.

To avoid delay and inconvenience, passengers are requested to co-
 operate by having their hand baggage ready for examination.

This examination does not apply to checked baggage carried in the
 baggage car.

In addition to the above there will be the usual examination by
 Canadian Customs and Immigration Officers.

NO PASSPORTS REQUIRED TO VISIT CANADA

Insofar as citizens of the United States are concerned they may
 enter and leave Canada as heretofore, without passports. Regula-
 tions do not require passports for United States citizens visiting
 Canada, although it is desirable that United States citizens have
 with them means of identification, such as birth certificates, natu-
 ralization papers, poll tax receipts or certificates from public officials
 who can certify American citizenship of the traveller.

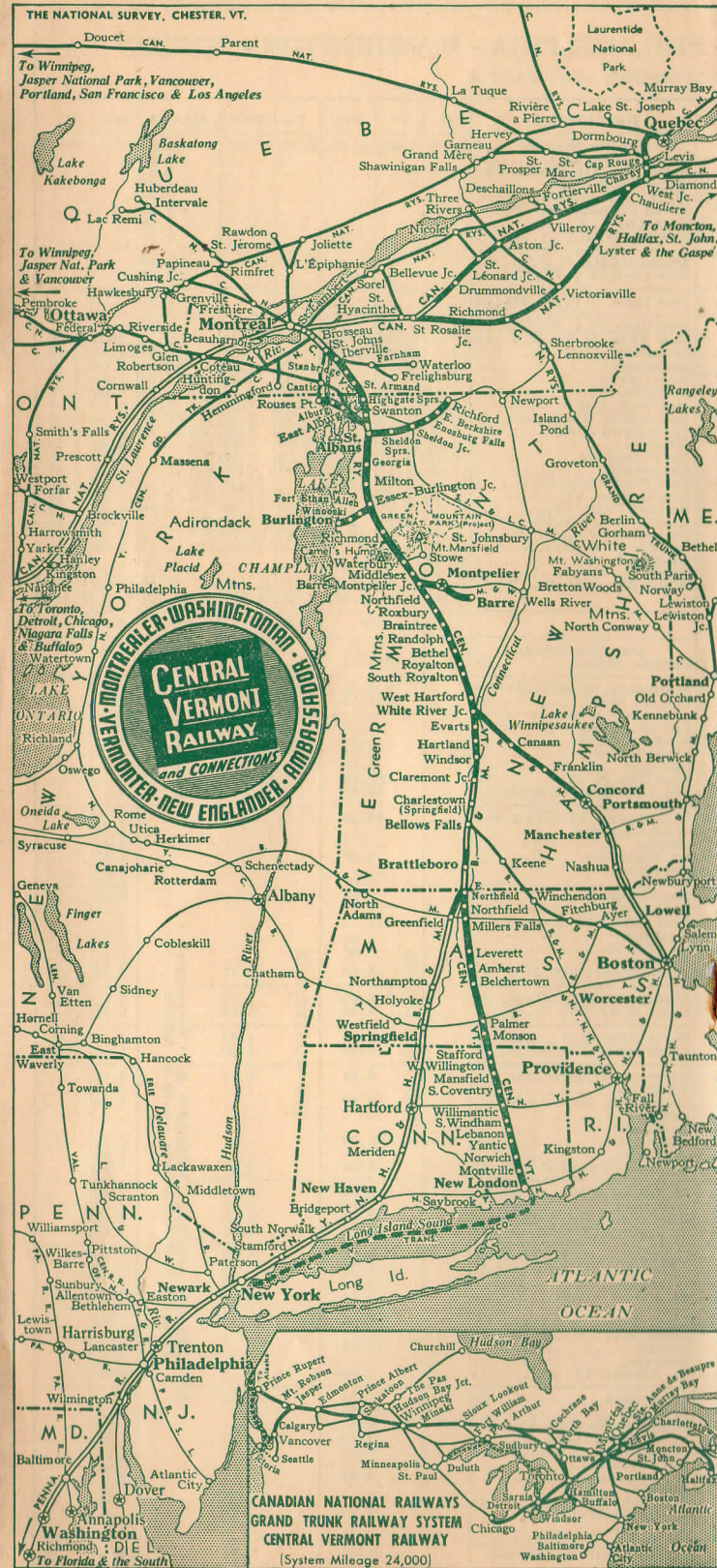
