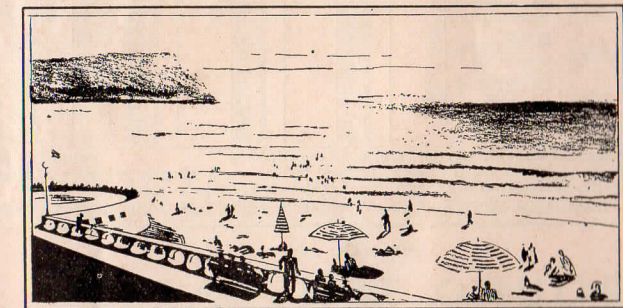

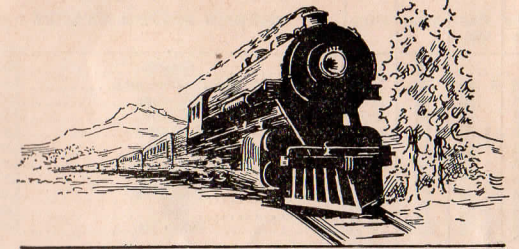

## PORTLAND—ASTORIA—SEASIDE LINE Along the Lower Columbia River



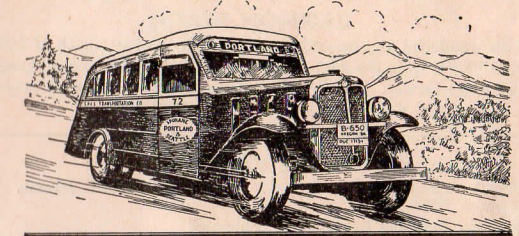
