CUSTOMS AND IMMIGRATION

United States Customs Officers will examine all passengers and their hand baggage, and United States Immigration Officers will examine all passengers entering the United States.

The Canadian Immigration and Customs Officers conduct similar examinations of all passengers and baggage entering Canada.

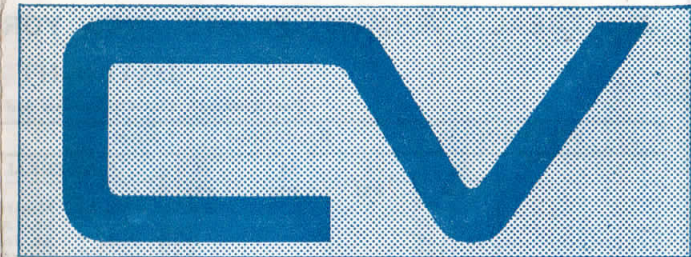
To avoid delay and inconvenience, passengers are requested to cooperate by having their identification papers and hand baggage ready for inspection. It is necessary that passengers be with their baggage when it is examined.

This examination does not apply to checked baggage carried in the baggage car.

NO PASSPORTS REQUIRED TO VISIT CANADA

Insofar as citizens of the United States are concerned they may enter and leave Canada as heretofore, without passports. Regulations do not require passports for United States citizens visiting Canada, although it is desirable that United States citizens have with them means of identification, such as birth certificates, naturalization papers, poll tax receipts or certificates from public officials who can certify American citizenship of the traveler.
