GENERAL INFORMATION

Daylight Saving Time is one hour faster than Standard Time, and is in effect in Northern Illinois, Wisconsin and Minnesota during the following periods in 1963: Chicago and Northern Illinois, April 28 through October 26; Wisconsin, April 28 through September 28; and Minnesota, May 26 through September 2.

Schedules. Every effort is made to show the correct schedules, but this company is not responsible for errors in timetables, nor for the inconvenience or damage resulting from delayed trains or failure to make connections. The right is reserved to change these schedules without advance notice.

Stoppers are allowed on many classes of tickets. Ask ticket agent for full information.

Children under 5 years are carried free when accompanied by parent or guardian; 5 years old and under 12, half-fare; 12 years old and over, full fare.

Ticket Redemption. Tickets unused or partly used will be redeemed under tariff regulations at proper value. Consult any C. & N. W. Railway Office, or write to the General Passenger Office of the railroad from which you purchased ticket.
