- RULE 221.** Light will not be displayed in train-order signals on Keeler Branch, except when train orders are to be delivered.

TRAIN AND AIR INSPECTION

Freight and mixed trains descending grade between Benton and Hammil will stop ten minutes at MP-487, Hammil, to allow heat to equalize in wheels and make inspection.

AIR BRAKE RULE 56.

One retaining valve for each 50 Ms will be turned up on freight and mixed trains Benton to Hammil.

SPEED RESTRICTIONS

Speed restrictions in miles per hour will apply as follows:

Do not exceed eight miles per hour on spur leading to quarry from wye at Beneme.
