SPECIAL RULES.

Bulletin Boards.

1. Conductors and engineers will consult Bulletin Boards daily at San Francisco, San Jose, Gilroy, Pajaro, Castroville and San Luis Obispo.

Registering Stations.

2. Trains will register at San Francisco, Spring Valley, Palo Alto, San Jose, Hillsdale, Gilroy, Pajaro, Castroville, Salinas, Pacific Grove, San Luis Obispo, Guadalupe, New Almaden, Tres Pinos, Aptos and Santa Cruz. The agents at Palo Alto, Spring Valley and Hillsdale will register trains not carded to stop at their stations.

Yard limits.

3. San Francisco yard limits extend from Third Street to Nineteenth Street; San Jose yard limits from Dawson Cannery Switch to Julian Street; Castroville yard limits from west switch to switch on San Luis Obispo line; Monterey yard limits from Monterey Depot to Del Monte Station; Aptos yard limits between station whistling posts; Santa Cruz yard limits commence opposite Sea Beach Hotel. Within these limits all trains must be under full control of enginemen.

Switches.

4. Switch at Carnadero must be left turned for Monterey line. Switch at Castroville must be left turned for Monterey line. Switches at Baden and San Bruno must be left turned for South San Francisco line.

Switching at Gilroy.

5. Engines must not be detached from cars while cars are moving between the north limit of the town of Gilroy and the south side of Old Gilroy Street.

Speed through cities and towns.

6. Trains will not run faster in city or town limits than the speed allowed by law, namely: San Francisco, eight miles per hour; Redwood, ten miles per hour; San Jose, eight miles per hour; Gilroy, ten miles per hour; Hollister, six miles per hour; Salinas, eight miles per hour.

Passing track for Valencia St.

7. Passing track for Valencia Street is the siding between Guerrero and Dolores Streets.

Freight trains carrying passengers.

8. Freight trains Nos. 91 and 92 will carry passengers. No other freight train will carry passengers, except as provided in Rule 242.

Pacific Grove and Lake Majella.

9. During the existence of this time table, engine and crew of Train No. 30 may use main line between Pacific Grove and Lake Majella between the hours of 9.00 A. M. and 10.00 A. M. for switching cars.

Loma Prieta line.

10. Train No. 71 will do the work on the Loma Prieta Branch, and will run on special orders only on that Branch, which will be issued when this card takes effect, and remain in force during its existence, or till modified or annulled.

11. On joint track between New Almaden station and junction of narrow gauge, Santa Cruz Division trains will have equal rights with trains of this Division. The switch at this junction will be kept set to make the Santa Cruz Division the continuous line. All trains between those points must be run carefully and under full control.

Trains to make special stops.

12. Trains No. 11, No. 2 and No. 12 will stop at Sholim to take or leave passengers.

Trains Nos. 9 and 12 will stop at Industrial School when flagged.

Trains Nos. 60, 63, 64, 66 and 67 will stop at Leonards, and No. 63 and No. 64 at New Brighton, to take or leave passengers.

On Sundays Trains No. 16 and No. 19 will stop at all way stations to take or leave passengers.

On Sundays Train No. 5 will stop at Millbrae, San Carlos, Fair Oaks and Lawrences to take or leave passengers.

Trains No. 9, No. 11, No. 15, No. 2, No. 10 and No. 12 will stop at Cypress Lawn for funeral parties or on display of Green and White Signal.

Trains No. 5 and No. 6 will stop at Rucker and Graves when flagged.

Train No. 6 will stop at Millbrae on Sundays only.

Clearance cards.

13. Conductors of all trains must report at train dispatcher's office and obtain orders or clearance cards before leaving San Francisco.

14. Trains on Tres Pinos line will register at Carnadero. Regular trains of Tres Pinos line when behind time will protect between Gilroy and Carnadero against regular trains on Monterey line. West-bound irregular trains will register at Carnadero (see Rule 95).

San Jose yard engines.

15. *San Jose yard engines* may use main track between College Park and San Jose, avoiding all regular trains. Within these limits *irregular trains* will keep careful watch for yard engines and run slowly. *Both yard engines and irregular trains will approach curve at Pottery Switch with train under full control*, and sound whistle (see Rule 49).

Descending heavy grades.

16. Trains descending grades between Santa Margarita and San Luis Obispo must at all times be kept fully under control, and must not exceed a speed of eighteen (18) and twenty-five (25) miles per hour respectively for freight and passenger trains, and must be kept not less than fifteen (15) minutes apart. Trains descending grades between San Francisco and Baden must at all times be kept fully under control, and the speed of freight trains must not exceed 18 miles per hour. Conductors will see personally that Rule 73 of the Westinghouse Automatic Air Brake Instructions is strictly complied with while descending these grades.

Standard clocks are located in dispatchers' offices at San Francisco and Castroville; also at Machine Shops 16th Street, Palo Alto, ticket office San Jose, Gilroy, Tres Pinos, Pajaro, Santa Cruz, Pacific Grove, Salinas and San Luis Obispo.

In pulling out of stations brakemen must watch wheels closely to see that brakes are fully released, and will immediately signal engineers to stop if wheels are found sliding. Engineers must keep a sharp lookout for such signals, as per Rule 278. Each brakeman will be held responsible for any wheel slid flat under the part of the train in his charge. Conductors in reporting flat wheels will give name of brakeman in charge.

See Rule 84, giving all west-bound trains absolute right of track over all trains of the same class running in the opposite direction. This rule does not apply to Train No. 13, which has absolute right of track over all west-bound trains.
