# SPECIAL RULES.

1. Engineers and conductors must examine bulletin board daily in the telegraph offices at Mendota, Fresno, Goshen Junction and Bakersfield.

2. The speed of passenger and freight trains must not exceed fifteen and eight miles per hour respectively while crossing the bridges over the San Joaquin, Kings and Kern rivers.

3. The limits of Fresno yard are from Standard Oil Co. Spur on the north to junction of the Fresno Division on the south. The northern limit of the Famoso yard is the junction of the Fresno Division with the main line. The northern limit of Bakersfield yard is one quarter of a mile north of the most northern switch. The southern limits of Bakersfield yard will extend to Corral Track, and all trains will proceed with care within these limits.

4. All trains must enter the yards at Mojave, Saugus, Fresno, Goshen Junction, Tulare, Famoso, Mendota, Collis, Armona and

Bakersfield with care, and under full control, expecting to find main track occupied.

5. In addition to junction points and terminals, Tehachapi, Palmdale, Vincent and Fernando will be registering stations.

6. All trains must procure either orders or clearance cards before leaving their terminal stations, except at Alcalde, Asphalto and Elwood.

7. At Collis the switch in the West Side main line between the water tank and the depot will be kept set for the siding, which siding through the Collis Yard, including the curve connecting it with the Fresno line, will be used as the Mendota-Fresno main line. At Armona the switch will be left set so as to make the Collis-Goshen line the main line.

8. Trains on the Alcalde Branch moving toward Alcalde will be regarded as going toward San Francisco as indicated on the Time Card.



# SPECIAL RULES.

All Trains will use at least *seven minutes* in passing through *San Fernando tunnel* (at a uniform rate of speed) and keep *red lights* burning on rear of train; and all engines must have head-light burning before entering tunnel.

*Santa Barbara yard* will extend to and include *Victoria Street station*. Trains will run with care.

*Mojave* will be terminal point for all trains.

Freight trains Nos. 25, 26, 27, 28, 57, 58, 63, 64, 65, 66, and Trains Nos. 21 and 22, east of Bakersfield, may carry passengers; no other freight trains will carry passengers, except on a special order, or as per Rule 242.

The limits of *Los Angeles yard* will extend to the *Yard-limit board west of the Los Angeles River*; and all trains will proceed with care within these limits.

Passenger trains, except Trains Nos. 19, 1000 and 1001, will stop on signal at Dundee and Roscoe Spurs, between Pacoima and Burbank.

Passenger trains will stop on signal at Montecito, Smith's Spur, Miramar, and Brownstone Spur.

Trains ascending grades will take siding for opposing trains of same class, except at points where necessary to take water between switches on main line. This will apply to freight trains of all classes at meeting points made by Dispatcher.

All east-bound trains must be under full control before passing through *tunnel just west of Saugus*. Speed must be reduced so that it will not be possible to strike any train or engine doing work at west switch. This, however, will not relieve conductors of responsibility of properly protecting their trains when standing at or doing work at that station.

Trains descending grade between *Tehachapi* and *Caliente*, and between *Vincent* and *Lang*, will keep fifteen (15) minutes apart, and it will be the duty of agents and operators to *flag* and advise any train following another within that limit. Freight trains may follow light engines ten (10) minutes apart.

Pusher engines, when coupled to rear end of train, *must in all cases cut off to take water*.

Passenger trains will not exceed a speed of twenty miles per hour between *Tehachapi* and tunnel west of *Caliente*, or twenty-two miles per hour between *Palmdale* and *Saugus*.

Freight trains will not exceed a speed of fifteen miles per hour between those points, or twenty-five miles per hour over any part of division.

Clocks at Mendota, Fresno, Goshen Junction, Bakersfield, Mojave, Palmdale, Saugus, Santa Barbara and Fernando will be Standard time for this Division.

In pulling out of stations, brakemen must watch wheels closely to see that brakes are fully released, and will immediately signal engineers to stop if wheels are found sliding. Engineers must keep a sharp lookout for such signals, as per Rule 278. Each brakeman will be held responsible for any wheels slid flat under the part of the train in his charge. Conductors in reporting flat wheels will give name of brakeman in charge.

*See Rule 84.—All west-bound trains have the absolute right of track over all trains of the same class running in the opposite direction.*
